The initial appointment will be for three years; upon successful evaluation, the position will be further extended for another three years.

Applicants will be expected to hold an excellent PhD in Mathematics as well as to have a demonstrable expertise in academic teaching.

- strong commitment to academic teaching;
- readiness to participate in interdisciplinary research;
- willingness and ability to attract external funding;
- readiness to contribute to joint research projects of the department.
