Venue:

Arrival:

By public transport from the central railway station of Bochum: Take the metro U35 in the direction of Bochum “Querenburg/Hustadt” and get off at the station “Ruhr-Universität.” It runs every five minutes in main hours and takes about 10 minutes (ticket class A). Walk over the pedestrian bridge, then follow the signposting along the library (“Bibliothek“) to the Audi Max and finally to the “Mensa” (student cafeteria). In the Mensa-Building are elevators at the southern side which bring you to level 04.

By taxi: It takes about 10-15 minutes from central station and costs ca. 12 Euros. Ask the driver to bring you to the Mensa-Building on “G-Südstraße.” Follow the signposting along the stairs outside to the “Veranstaltungszentrum” (event centre) on level 04.

By car: Take highway A 43 (Wuppertal-Recklinghausen) until exit 19 “Bochum-Querenburg/Ruhr Universität.” Proceed your way in the direction of “Universität/Bochum-Zentrum” along the Universitätsstraße and exit at “Uni-Mitte.” (Alternatively, coming from Bochum downtown, take the Universitätsstraße outbound and exit at “Uni-Mitte.”) Follow the exit lane and turn left through a tunnel, then at the end of the road turn left and immediately left again to the parking garage P9 which is under the Mensa-Building (student-cafeteria). Follow the signposting along the stairs outside of the building to “Veranstaltungszentrum” (event centre) on level 04.

From Hotel Lottental: The footpath through a little forest takes you to the south side of the Mensa-Building (student-cafeteria) in about 10-15 minutes (ask hotel staff for the direction). Follow the signposting along the stairs outside to “Veranstaltungszentrum” (event centre) on level 04. You can also go by taxi (ca. 10 minutes).
