



Please note the following additional important information:

Talks:

- Please present your projects broadly (related results and research activities, starting point of SPP project, overall project objectives and scientific questions, specific aims and approaches, results to date). It is preferred that PIs or experienced researchers give the talks.

Posters:

- In two poster sessions on 14 March, all attendees who are not PIs and are not presenting in a talk should show the plans and status of their specific projects (e.g., a PhD project; also for each individual sub-project within a larger collaborative project in the SPP).
- On the poster, please show below title, authors and affiliations: photos (with names) of student and PI (and, if applicable, directly involved coworkers). The posters should show in an easily accessible form the overall objectives and scientific questions, specific aims experiments/approaches to be followed, possibly initial results. Please make it short and simple: VERY LITTLE text!!! (Please use A0 upright; width 84.1 cm, height 118.9 cm).
- If you are bringing a poster, please send a brief email to Angelika Ernst before 23 February, mentioning that you are bringing a poster, title, authors.
