Language: classes will be held in English.

<u>Eligibility</u>: the SELSS is open to a maximum of 25 participants. The participants must hold at least a three years University degree (180 ECTS) in the relevant matters of the School (economics & business administration, history, international relations, law, political and social sciences). A good command of English is required.

<u>Fees:</u> \in 3.000. The fees cover: a) participation to the classes; b) learning materials; c) accommodation with breakfast and lunch at the halls of residence of the hosting Universities; d)travel expenses from Padua to Leuven (one way).

<u>Scholarships</u>: 10 scholarships of \in 2.000 each will be offered on a competitive basis. A further lump sum up to a maximum of \in 500 for the travel costs to the University of Padua will be offered to the beneficiaries of the scholarships coming from regions outside Europe.

<u>Certificate</u>: at the full completion of the School participants will receive a participation certificate, acknowledging 8 ECTS.
