Mutter Wittig (Cuisine: German; some vegetarian and vegan options)

Zum Grünen Gaul (Cuisine: German; some vegetarian and vegan options)

Kimbap Spot (Cuisine: Korean; vegan)

Burger restaurant close to the main station. Serving mainly burgers and salads with many vegetarian and vegan options.

Levarosa (Cuisine: Oriental, Arabic; vegetarian options)

Fräulein Coffea (Café)

Cosy café close to the theatre with good coffee and a great selection of homemade cakes, many of them vegan.

Sights in Bochum

RUB Botanical Garden (Bochum)

Adjacent to the conference venue, the Botanic Garden spreads across the south slope of the Ruhr University Campus. Covering an area of 13 hectares and harbouring over 10,000 different plant species, it is one of Germany's largest botanic gardens.

Deutsches Bergbau-Museum (German Mining Museum)

The *Deutsches Bergbau-Museum* Bochum – established in 1930 – explores the history of the extraction, processing and use of geo-resources across the ages. It is the largest mining museum in the world. There is a permanent exhibition and a visitor's mine, and you can also go up the mining tower. Address: Am Bergbaumuseum 28, 44791 Bochum

Sights in the Ruhr Area and Beyond

Folkwang Museum (Essen)

One of the most renowned German art museums with an outstanding collection of 19th-century painting and sculpture, classical modernism and art after 1945, as well as photography.

Distance from Bochum HBF: approx. 20 minutes by train + 15-minute walk

Villa Hügel (Essen)

With its 269 rooms, set in the middle of a 28-hectare park overlooking Lake Baldeney, the Villa Hügel was home to the industrialist Krupp family from 1873 to 1945.

Distance from Bochum HBF: approx. 40 minutes by public transport + a short walk, easier to reach by car

Dortmunder U (Dortmund)

Located in a former brewery building close to the main station, the Dortmunder U is a centre for the arts and creativity. Visit the Museum Ostwall, located on the fourth and fifth floor, and discover their huge collection of modern art (with a focus on Expressionism and Fluxus), visit one of the many temporary exhibitions on the other floors or get a drink on the roof terrace overlooking all of Dortmund. Deutsches Fußballmuseum (Dortmund)

The German Football Museum portrays the triumphs as well as defeats of both German club football and the German National Team.

Halde Hoheward (Herten)

Part of the Industrial Heritage Trail, the Halde Hoheward is a spoil tip right in the middle of the Ruhr area and today serves as a monument to German mining history.

K20 (Düsseldorf)

The collection on display at K20 has been assembled since 1961 and includes major works of classical modernism. Artists include Paul Klee, Max Beckmann, Wassily Kandinsky, Ernst Ludwig Kirchner, Henri Matisse, and Pablo Picasso.

Gasometer (Oberhausen)

Built in the late 1920s, Europe's largest disc-type gas holder is an impressive reminder of the heavy industry that characterised the Ruhr area for more than a century. Check their website for current exhibitions.

Schloss Benrath (Benrath Palace and Park) (Düsseldorf)

A Baroque-style *maison de plaisance* (pleasure palace) in Benrath, Düsseldorf. It was erected for the Elector Palatine Charles Theodor and his wife, Countess Palatine Elisabeth Auguste of Sulzbach, by Nicolas de Pigage. Construction began in 1755 and was completed in 1770.

Burg Vischering (Vischering Castle) (Münsterland)

Cities

Cologne

The historic city centre next to the Rhine is worth a visit; so is the world-famous Cologne Cathedral located right next to the main station. There are some great museums close to the main station as well, such as the Museum Ludwig (20th-century and contemporary art), the Wallraf-Richartz-Museum (medieval period to the early 20th century) and the Roman-Germanic Museum.

Distance from Bochum HBF: approx. 90 minutes by public transport

Münster

Charming city with a historical city centre, great for sightseeing or stopping for coffee and cake in one of the many cafés. Münster's gothic Town Hall, the Erbdrostenhof Palace and the Picasso Museum are all worth a visit.

Distance from Bochum HBF: approx. 70 minutes by public transport

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
