



## Marking Key

- ✓ Good or important point.
- ┌ A word or several words is/are missing.
- (...) The words inside the bracket are superfluous.
- ? Lack of clarity; reader does not understand what you mean.
- acad** Violation of the rules of academic style (quotation, references, etc.); consult style sheet.
- co** Lack of coherence between sentences or paragraphs.
- coll** Colloquial language that is inappropriate in academic prose (*kids* for *children*, *won't* for *will not*; too frequent use of *get*, *sort of*, etc.).
- exp** Unidiomatic expression.
- f** Error concerning facts.
- g** Grammatical mistake.
- log** Faulty logic, for instance a contradiction between two claims.
- p** Punctuation mistake.
- para** Paragraph is not a sense unit, not indented or too short.
- ref** The antecedent of a pronoun is unclear, non-existent or too far away. "In *Moll Flanders*, she marries several husbands." Revised: "In *Moll Flanders*, the heroine marries ..."
- rep** Inelegant repetition of words or unnecessary repetition of ideas.
- source** You need to cite a source for a claim you make.
- sp** Spelling mistake.
- t** The tense is wrong.
- w** Mistake in word choice. "Their economical policy had disastrous effects." Revised: "Their economic policy had disastrous effects."
- wo** Mistake in word order.
