On the traces of the big composer Beethoven's Bonn

In December 1770, Ludwig van Beethoven was born at the Bonngasse 20 in Bonn. Beethoven lived in Bonn until 1792, before he moved to Vienna, where he became one of the most famous composers of the world. His house of birth has been the landmark of Bonn for ages, his monument dominates the Münsterplatz, a concert hall and an orchestra are named after him. Already at the age of twelve he composed sonatas, which have been the basis of every musical education up until today: Ludwig van Beethoven is the city's biggest son, a city which is intensively connected with this Titan of musical art.

On our guided tour (approx. 1,5 hours) you will visit places and locations where the world-famous composer worked and you will get fascinating views into his everyday life.
